## Topline results

## National Political Poll for Esquire/Yahoo! News

This survey was conducted by landline and cellular telephone Sept. 7-10, 2012, among a random national sample of 1,002 adults. Results have a margin of sampling error of plus or minus 4 percentage points for the full sample, 4.5 points for registered voters and 5 points for likely voters. The survey was produced for Esquire/Yahoo! News by Langer Research Associates, with sampling, data collection and tabulation by Interviewing Service of America of Van Nuys, CA.

Full topline results follow. An asterisk indicates a response given by fewer than 0.5 percent of respondents. "GP" indicates results among the general public, RV among registered voters and LV among likely voters.
